5.	Who were Habakkuk's contemporaries?
6.	What is Habakkuk's complaint? Verses 2-4.
7.	What can we gather from this complaint about the spiritual health of Israel at this time?

8.	Do you ever feel the way that Habakkuk feels?
9.	Where is one place that justice comes out of, and what should this mean for us today?
10.	If when the wicked surround the righteous and it causes the law to be paralyzed and perverse justice to go forth, would true justice and law be the result if righteous people surround the wicked? Reference is verse 4.
11.	What is God's answer? Verses 5-11. See also, Acts 13: 36-41; Daniel 3:1.
12.	What is Habakkuk's second complaint? Verse 1:12-2:1.
13.	What principle can we learn from Habakkuk's questions to God?
