2.	Is Job a real person? See also, Genesis 46:13; Ezekiel 14:14, 20; James 5:11.
3.	How would you describe the type of man Job was at the start of this book? What kind of family life did he have?
4.	What does verse 5 tell us about Job and the time period of the setting?

5.	Verse 6 switches the scene, where does this take place and who is there? Is Job aware of this?
6.	Who lays down the challenge about Job? See verse 8.
7.	What is it that God is saying about Job in verse 8?
8.	What is Satan's premise in the question in verses 9-11?
9.	What does verse 12 tell you about the relationship between God and Satan?

10.	Once Satan is given reign what does he do? And what is Job's response? Verses 13-22.
11.	What does verse 20 hint about in consideration of the time of this event? See also, Leviticus 21:5-6.
12.	What does Job mean in verse 21 about returning to his mother's womb? See also, Genesis 2:7.
