7.	What's Job's wife's response to the trials that come upon Job and how does Job respond to her in the midst of the pain and what does this tell you about Job? Verses 9-10.
8.	Why don't Job's friends recognize him in verse 12? And are they good friends? Verses 7, 11-13.
9.	Having read chapters 1 and 2, is adversity in life - trial and difficulty - linked to the sin in one's life?
10.	Who in history has been completely innocent and still suffered?
