5. What is Job saying in verses 7-8 of chapter 28?
6. In verses 12-13, 20, Job asks an important question, what is it and what is the answer?

7. What is it in the opening of chapter 29 that Job longs for?

8. What do verses 6 of chapter 29 remind you of in the Bible and what is Job saying about his life and the Lord?

9. In your reading of chapter 29 how do you think Job viewed himself? What doesn't he acknowledge?

10. In the first half of chapter 30 Job goes into detail on how people view him now that he is afflicted by God, what is his cry to God in verse 31 and what does he say about God?

11. Chapter 31 opens with a well-known piece of Scripture, what is it Job recognized about sin and what can we learn from his statement?

13. What does Job recognize in verse 15 of chapter 31?
