9.	What do you make of verses 33:23-30? Compare it with 9:32-33 and 19:25-27.

10.	What is Elihu declaring about God and about this circumstance Job finds himself in with the statement in verse 34:10-30?
11.	What is Elihu's premise/thesis in chapter 35:1-8?
12.	What is Elihu claiming in 36:1-4 and does it surprise you? is he wrong?
13.	What is Elihu warning against in verses 36:17-23?
14.	What is the theme of chapters 36-37 in a few words?
