

JOB BIBLE STUDY

CHAPTER 40-41

1. Read 1 Corinthians 10:13 and then read Job 40-41 and write down any questions or insights that occur to you.
2. What does God call Job in verse 40:1-2 and what, or who, does it remind you of?
See also Isaiah 45:9-11.
3. Is the Lord satisfied with Job's answer in verses 40:3-5? What challenge does He give to Job in verses 6-14?
4. Is the Behemoth real or a symbol or both? What do you think it is?
Verse 40:15. See also, Revelation 13:11.
5. Where does the Behemoth dwell?
Verses 15-24.

6. In verse 40:24 God asks Job if he can capture the Behemoth by the eye or pierce its nose with a snare, what does this mean?
See also Isa 37:29.

7. Is the Leviathan real or a symbol or both? What do you think it is?
Verses 41:1-34. See also, Psalms 74:14, 104:26; Isaiah 27:1; Revelation 13:1.

8. Where does the Leviathan dwell?

9. God asks Job again if he can capture the Leviathan with rope or hook in verse 41:2 much like He did about the Behemoth a couple of verses earlier. What is God trying to across to Job?

10. What is God's view of (or relation too) the Leviathan based on verses 41:2-10? What does God say is man's view of (or relation too) the leviathan?

11. What is God saying about Himself in verse 41:11 and about everyone else?

12. What does God mean in calling the Leviathan "king over all the sons of pride" in verse 41:34?
See also Exodus 5:2; Psalms 73:6; Isaiah 28:1; Ezekiel 29:3; Matthew 16:23; 1 Timothy 3:6; 1 John 2:16; 1 Peter 5:5; Revelation 12:3, 20:3.
