Bible Study

1. Write down any questions or insights you have from your reading and preparation for the Bible study.
2. Who does John hear praising God in verses 1 through 3 and compare it to Revelation 18:9-10.
3. What event is announced by the “great multitude” in verses 6 through 8?
4. How has the Bride made herself ready for this moment and how should this direct us in our daily lives as Christians individually and collectively as the Church?
Verse 7-8. See also, Isaiah 61:10-11; Matthew 22:11-14; Romans 13:14; Ephesians 5:26-27; Titus 3:8.

5. Who is invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb?
Verse 9. See also, Matthew 22:1-14; Luke 14:12-24.

6. Who comes forth from heaven in verse 11 and for what purpose?
Verses 11-21.

7. Why is the rider's robe dipped in blood before the battle begins in verse 13?

8. What is the sword that comes from the rider's mouth in verse 15?
See also, 2 Thessalonians 2:8; Hebrews 4:12.

9. What event takes place in verses 17-22 and what does the angel call it?
See also, Deuteronomy 28:15, 26; Ezekiel 39:17-29; Matthew 24:28.

10. What does the world do when Christ comes, what happens to Satan, the beast, the false prophet, and those that fought with them? Who goes to the Lake of Fire and why might this be significant?
Verses 19:19-20:3.
