1. Read chapter eleven of Romans and record any questions or thoughts that come to you as you read.
2. What evidence does Paul give to prove that God has not rejected the Jewish people?
Verses 1-5.
3. What does Paul mean by verse 6?
See also Acts 15:11; Romans 4:4-5; Ephesians 2:8-9.
4. What's the answer to Paul's question in verse eleven, "So I ask, did they stumble in order that they might fall?" From what did they fall?

5. What has come out of the stumbling of the Jews?
Verses 12-16.

6. What is the meaning of verse sixteen? Who or what is the dough offered as firstfruits? Who or what is the root and the branches?
See also, Numbers 15:17-21; Jeremiah 2:21.

7. Is Paul saying that fellow Christian Gentiles can be removed from the root? What is this verse saying?
Verse 22. See also John 15:4-10; Hebrews 6:1-8; Romans 8:37-39.

8. Will Israel come back to the Lord?
Verses 25-36.
