7.	What is your favorite verse in verses 3 through 21 and why?
8.	If this chapter is written on how to related to fellow believers, why would verses 14, 16, and 18-20 be a problem that Paul would list it?
9.	Do you think that verse 20 is meant to vengeful? If not then what?
