1.	Read chapter three of Romans and record any questions or thoughts that come to you as you read.
2.	What value does Paul say that there is in being of Jewish descent? Verses 1-4. See also Psalm 147.
3.	Who would think the unfaithful behavior of the Jews would cancel out God's faithfulness and why? Verses 1-8.
4.	In your own words, what is Paul saying in verses five and six?

5.	Who does Paul quote to answer the argument he puts for in verse nine?  Verses 9 - 18.
6.	Why is it that no one born in sinful flesh will be justified in God's sight when compared against the Law? In consideration of this, what is the purpose of the Law? Verse 20.
7.	What is "the righteousness of God that has been manifested (made visible) apart from the law"?  Verse 21. See also Isaiah 53, 54:17, 61:10; Jeremiah 23:5-6; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Philippians 3:9.
8.	What does propitiation used in verse twenty-five mean?
