1.	Read chapter six of Romans and record any questions or thoughts that come to you as you read.
2.	What argument does Paul seek to destroy in the opening of Romans 6? Verses 1-2. See also Galatians 5:13; 1 Peter 2:16-19; Jude 1:4.
3.	What is Paul saying took place for us in verses three and four? See also Colossians 3:1-3.
4.	What's the fact that Paul notes in verse five? See also Philippians 3:10; John 12:24.
5.	According to Paul what is our state as a born again believer in Christ Jesus? Verses 6-11.

6.	If we are dead to sin, why do we still struggle with temptation and then give into sin? Verse 12; See also 1 Peter 4:1-2, 2:11; Romans 7: 23-24; 1 Corinthians 15:53-54; 2 Corinthians 5:4; Galatians 5:16.
7.	How are we to live as believers according to verses fifteen through nineteen? See also 2 Peter 1:2-10; 1 John 2:1-6.
8.	What is sanctification and how do we get it?  Verse 22. See also; 1 Corinthians 1:30; 1 Thessalonians 4:3,7; 2 Thessalonians 2:13; Hebrews 12:14; 1 Peter 1:2.
9.	If the "wages of sin is death," why is it that Paul writes that "the free gift of God is eternal life" and not "the wages of God is eternal life"? Verse 23.
