5.	For whom is God's message in verses 2:10-13? Verse 14.
6.	What is the reason God asks the questions about holy meat and unclean things? Verses 2:11-19.

7.	What is the significance of the holy meat being carried in the fold of the garment? Verse 2:12.
8.	What is God saying about the condition of the people working on the temple? Verses 2:14
9.	What was the result in the lives of the people because of their spiritual condition and who caused that result? Verses 2:15-17.
10.	What's God's promise in verses 2:18-19 and why does He make this promise to them?
11.	What event is being referenced in verses 2:21-22? Consider Matt 24:6-7, 29.

12. To 12,	whom is Zerubbabel related and why is this important? See Matt 1:1-17 (specifically verse, you may need to check out different translations).
13. Wł 2:2	nat is the significance of God saying that He will make Zerubbabel "like a signet ring"? Verse 3.
