4.	How is his reaction here in chapter four different from his reaction to the first dream in chapter 2?
5.	What do the "wise men" reveal about themselves in their response to the king's dream? Verse 7
6.	Why does the king say of Daniel that "the spirit of the holy gods is in" him? Verses 8-9.
7.	What is a watcher and what does the king tell us about him? Verse 13.

8.	Why do you suppose that Daniel was "dismayed" or alarmed by the dream of the king? Verse 19.
9.	Who brings about the judgment upon the king and is it significant who carries it out? Verses24-33.
10.	How long does the king live in this outcast state? Verse 32.
11.	How does the king get restored? Verses 34-36.
12.	What does King Nebuchadnezzar come to recognize about himself and about God?
13.	What is the lesson you take away from this chapter?
