1.	Read through the chapter and right down any questions or thoughts that occur to you.
2.	To what or whom is Moses compared? To what or whom is Jesus compared? What does this comparison tell us about both? Verses 1-6.
3.	To what are we compared and what are the implications of this comparison for us as we go about our lives? Verse 6.
4.	What act of rebellion did the forefathers do that is spoken of in verses 7 through 11?
5.	What rest is it that the forefathers did not enter into and how is this used as an exhortation for us? Verses 11-17.

6.	Why do you think encouraging our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ is important in keeping us from becoming "hardened by sin's deceitfulness" and helps keep us from turning away from the "living God" (NIV)? Verse 12-14.
7.	Why does the writer draw a comparison in this chapter to the people Moses led out of Egypt and believers in Christ?
