

Bible Study: The Gospel of John

Chapter 19

1. Read through the questions of this Bible study. Now read chapter 19 of John and write down any questions and insights that come to you.
2. Why did Pilate have Jesus flogged, particularly if he could find no basis for a charge against Him? Verses 1-6.
3. Why didn't the Jews just take Christ and crucify Him themselves like Pilate suggested? Verses 6,7.
4. Why was Pilate afraid? Verse 7-10.
5. Of whom is Christ referring in verse 11, when He said, "Therefore the one who handed me over to you is guilty of a greater sin"?

6. What is the importance of verses 14-16?

7. Why might it be important in the Gospel account to note that Jesus was crucified between two other men? Verse 18.

8. Why do you think Pilate had the sign hung above Jesus's head? Verse 19-22.

9. Why are we given the account of Jesus's clothes being divided and cast lots for? Verses 23-24.

10. What did the event in verses 25-27 tell us about Christ?

11. Is there any significance in verse 30's account of Christ's death? See also Matt 27:50 and Luke 23:46.

12. Why does John include verse 35 in the Gospel account?

13. Is it significant that Christ's body is placed in a new tomb? Verses 41, 42.
