

**BIBLE STUDY CHAPTER 7**  
**THE GOSPEL OF JOHN**

1. Read through the questions of this Bible study then read chapter 7 of John and write down any questions and insights that come to you.
  
2. What principle(s) do we find in the actions and words of Christ in verses 1 through 8?
  
3. What did Christ's brothers have in mind for Christ? Verses 3,4.
  - a. What did God the Father have in mind for Christ? Try to site scriptural references.
  
4. Verse 5 tells us that not even Christ's brothers believed in Him at this point in time, but did that ever change? For a list of His brothers see Matthew 13:55, also see 1 Corinthians 9:5 and Galatians 1:19.
  
5. Why did Christ wait and then go in secret to the Feast of Tabernacles? Verses 1-13.

6. What is Christ saying His goal is in His speech to the Jews in verses 16-19?
  
7. What miracle is Jesus referring to in verses 21 through 24?
  
8. In verses 25 through 27 and verses 41 through 44 we read two different things about "the Christ" that the Jews looked for and His origins. They appear in opposition. Why is this?
  
9. What is Christ talking about in verses 33-34?
  
10. When would the incident take place and those who believe in Christ receive the Spirit John writes about in verses 37 through 39?
  
11. Who did the people in verse 31 think Christ was?
  
12. What did Nicodemus point out to the Pharisees about themselves? Verses 45 through 52.
