1.	Read chapter twelve and write down any questions or insights that you have that you can share with the rest of the group.
2.	What is God declaring about Himself in verse one? See also Genesis 3; Psalm 102:25-28; Psalm 104.
3.	What is the meaning of "a cup of staggering"? See also Jeremiah 25:15-29, 51:7.
4.	What is the meaning of Jerusalem being a "heavy stone for all the peoples"? See also, Psalm 125; Daniel 2:31-35; Matthew 21:33-46.

5.	What is God saying He is going to do in verse four and what is the response of the people as given in verse five? See also Zechariah 10:5; Psalm 76:5-7.
6.	What is meaning of the simile in verse six? See also Deuteronomy 4:24, 9:3.
7.	What does God mean when He says that "the feeblest among them on that day shall be like David"? Verse 8. See also 1 Samuel 13:14, 29:5; Micah 5:8, 7:16.
8.	What causes the people referenced in verse ten to mourn and weep? See also John 19:31-37.
