

Chapter 6 Bible Study

1.	Read chapter six and write down any questions or insights that you have.
2.	What are the two mountains and why are they made of bronze (some translations say brass)? Verse 1. See also, Zechariah 14:4; Matthew 24:3; Luke 21:37; Psalm 48:2, 11; Psalm 125:1; Isaiah 24:23; Micah 4:7.
3.	Who are the four chariots in verses one through eight and what do the colors of the horses signify? See Revelation 6.
4.	What does the Lord mean or indicate when He says in verse eight that the chariots that went to the north have quieted His spirit? See also, Deuteronomy 12:10; Isaiah 1:24.

Why did the Lord single out the three exiles in verse ten? Consider the meaning of their names and the alternate spelling or nickname in verse fourteen.
What is God asking Zechariah to do in verses nine through fourteen? Why is it significant?
Who is the Branch? See Isaiah 11:1, 53:2; Jeremiah 23:5, 33:15. Consider also the proclamation, "Behold the man" in verse 12 and John 19:5.
What was to be done with the crown? Verse 14.
